

# Quick Guide: setting up a



## Facebook Fundraiser

In a few quick steps you can set up a Facebook Fundraiser and easily start collecting donations from family and friends for taking part in our Paws for Prevention challenge.

### Step 1 – Logging on

Log into your Facebook account via your mobile or desktop and you are ready to go.

### Step 2 – Choosing to fundraise

On a desktop? Click on the fundraise button in the left-hand panel and follow the steps

On a mobile? Choose the menu at the top right-hand corner and then select Fundraise and follow the steps

### Step 3 – Selecting Breast Cancer UK

You will see two options, choose to raise money for Not for Profit and then pick your charity by simply entering Breast Cancer UK in the search bar and clicking on our logo

### Step 4 – Setting your fundraising target

You may choose to set your fundraising target at £25, knowing you will smash it, or stretch yourself with a higher target of £250!

The choice is yours. Everything you raise using Facebook will be donated to Breast Cancer UK.

Don't forget to add the date you aim to finish the challenge to encourage your friends and family to support you.

## Step 5 – What is your fundraiser and why
