## Virtual Fundraising Ideas

### Run Santa Run

Don a Santa's hat, take to the streets and set yourself an exercise challenge of your choice this December. Decide on a challenge that suits you – whether it is running 5K, walking 20k or cycling 50K all you need to do is set up a [Just Giving page](#) and ask your friends, family and colleagues to sponsor you as you face the wintery weather and bring some festive cheer to people as you pass by in your Santa's hat!

All you need to do is:

All you need to do is:

All you need to do is:
